GENERAL

- FTK Fridays are back! Donuts are sold each Friday in front of the school for \$1 each. (It will be Thursday this week, due to no school Friday.) As always, it's For the Kids and all proceeds go to Buchholz's Dance Marathon organization.
- Juniors and Seniors Herff Jones will be on Campus Wed, Thur & Friday 1/22-1/24 to take Senior orders for Cap & Gown and announcements and Junior orders for Class rings. Look for them in the mall during both lunches.
- HPV, Meningitis and Hepatitis vaccines for 11th and 12th graders! - Forms were sent home Friday the 10th with all 11th and 12th grade students. The forms are due back to the school January 15th. The vaccine clinic will take place on Thursday, January 23rd at 8:00 AM in the auditorium. Two quick notes:
 - For seniors, colleges and universities require a student to have the meningitis vaccine (unless they have a religious waiver.)
 - The HPV vaccine can be very expensive and this is completely free to the students now. This vaccine protects against future cervical and testicular cancers.
- Magnet Programs: The window for local families to apply for their children to attend one of Alachua County Public Schools' academic or career and technical magnet programs opened January 7th and will close February 3rd. The application, magnet program requirements, notification timeframe, and other information is available on the SBAC website. Hard copies of this information are also available in the front office.
- Night School Driver Education Announcement: Anyone interested in Night School Driver Education, registration is now open. Classes meet twice a week, you must be 15 years old, and you do NOT need a Learners Permit to start the class. - Scholarship Opportunities
 - The Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority will award \$1,000 scholarships to deserving African-American high school seniors who demonstrate scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0 or higher) and who are active in volunteer community service. Application Deadline is February 16th.
 - Seniors- the Santa Fe College Foundation scholarship deadline is February 15- if you are planning to attend Santa Fe in the fall and have not already completed the scholarship application- what are you waiting for?
 - Junior and Seniors College Board Opportunity Scholarships - Applying to college is a complicated process, so College Board has created a program that guides you through it. This scholarship program is open to all current juniors and seniors. It does not require an essay, application, or minimum GPA. Instead, it rewards your effort and initiative.
