- IMPORTANT Bright Futures Information for SENIORS: The Office of Student Financial Assistance (OSFA) will begin evaluations of 2019-20 high school seniors in late March. In order for a student to qualify for Bright Futures, all five of the below requirements must be met:
 - Submit a complete Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA), also known as the state application, no later than August 31, 2020, at <https://www.FloridaStudentFinancialAidsg.org>;
 - Complete the required coursework (by high school graduation 5/29/2020);
 - Achieve the required grade point average in the required coursework;
 - Complete the required number of service hours (by high school graduation 5/29/2020);
 - Achieve the required college entrance exam score (no later than June 30, 2020).
