- ACSB Community Service Policy "Fact of the Day" **Non-Examples** that are **not** considered community service for purposes of this policy include but are not limited to:
  - personal preparation for an event (rehearsal, practice, packing suitcases, plane ride, sleeping or eating at the site where community service is rendered);
  - performing community service during school hours on days school is in session;
  - working at game concessions to earn money for a club or activity with the proceeds credited to individual student indebtedness (fair share);
  - working at a business that produces revenue from the work performed by the student(s); or
  - community service hours provided as a result of court action.
- FAFSA - All seniors planning to attend college should complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) application online. Completing a FAFSA application is a necessary step to being eligible for federal Pell Grant, work-study, and loan assistance. Information from the FAFSA is often also used by colleges and universities to determine eligibility for need and merit-based scholarships, and state financial aid money. If you would like assistance completing a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) application online, then to attend the Career Discoveries Day program at Buchholz High School on Saturday, November 16th from 10:30 a.m. until noon in the Buchholz High School media center. To complete a FAFSA application, you need to bring the following information with you:
  - Parent Information:
    - Parent(s) social security number, date of birth, and email address.
    - Date parents were married/divorced (if they were married).
    - Copy of parents' 1040 tax form (from last Spring based on 2018 income).
    - Estimate of how much money parents have in their bank account after the bills are paid each month (if they have a bank account).
    - Investment information (if the parents have investments)
    - Cell Phone (if the parent has one)
  - Senior Information:
    - Student social security number, date of birth, and email address.
    - Copy of student's 1040 tax form (from last Spring based on 2018 income), or W-2 form, if the student worked.
    - Student driver's license number.
    - Cell phone (if the student has one).
