- The Education Foundation of Alachua County Senior Scholarships: Scholarships range from \$1,000 to \$6,000 for Alachua County Public Schools seniors who meet the scholarships' criteria. Please note, the Education Foundation advises against using Al tools, such as ChatGPT, to write essays, as doing so could result in disqualification from consideration for the scholarships. High school seniors in the Alachua County Public Schools system can apply here. Deadline is February 21, 2025.

For more information regarding SF Foundation scholarships, please visit the <u>foundation website</u>. Students must have a Santa Fe College SF ID to complete an application. If their admissions application is more than 365 days old, they must be enrolled in current courses to have access to the applications. If you have issues completing the application, students may contact the Foundation office at 352-395-5200 for assistance.
