- A. Cognia Accreditation Report- Mr. Purvis reviewed the report that was submitted. The report was thorough and well put together. It received a score of 352 IEQ which is above average.
- **B. Approved Expenditures Report-** Mr. Purvis explained the approved budget funds and where the funds are allocated.

- C. Request of SRP Funds for 25-26 Tutoring not to exceed \$10,000.00- A. Gandy motioned to approve. R. McNickle seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- **D.** Request ADS funding for five instructional units for 2025-2026- J. Morey motioned to approve. A. Packwood seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- E. Request of ADS funds to pay for two Paraprofessionals 1 position for safety/security (approximately \$80,000.00 for both positions)- A. Gandy motioned to approve. A. Packwood seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

F. Request of ADS funds for Wall Mount Shade for Mall Area not to exceed \$30,000.00- K. Bonhonme motioned to approve. D. Munson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

VII. Reports- Administration

- **A. SAC Elections-** Mr. Purvis asked anyone who needed to leave the committee to let him know. The 25-26 school year will be year two of current SAC members. The next election cycle will be for the 26-27 school year.
- B. BHS Reports-
 - 1.School Data- Mr. Purvis explained the data from the report. Students with Disabilities and African American students need the most support. Teachers meet weekly to evaluate lesson plans and strategies to improve test scores.
- **C. Facilities, Safety & Security-** Mr. Jones updated us on how well the hall monitors are doing. The halls and bathrooms are safer and utilized better. He would like to get 20 more cameras to cover any blind spots on the current camera setup. He also spoke about lighting in the parking area to increase security. All the gates are working better.
- **D. Student Services-** Mrs. Smith spoke about another evaluation for the students success called the BPIE. It was congruent with the other testing that showed Students With Disabilities and African American students need the most support. Teachers and Administrators have a plan and are implementing it in the classroom.
- E. Curriculum/Testing- Administration let us know that they are helping the test coordinator get ready for all the testing that will begin after spring break. The calendar shows the testing schedule. Students are currently meeting with counselors to create their schedules for next year via our Individual Advising Sessions. Allocations will come out for next year and administration will start planning accordingly.

VIII. Open Agenda: Public Input- Mr. Purvis reported BHS has partnered with the Nike/Jordan brand for sports. The Bobcat logo was updated.
