INTRODUCTIONS

APPROVAL OF MINUTES The minutes of the April 23, 2015, DAC meeting were unanimously

PRESENTATION/DISCUSSION/ APPROVAL OF MEMBER-SUGGESTED ISSUES Copies of the prioritized topics that Ms. Plavac had put together were distributed and discussed, each individually. Discussions were centered on rural vs. city schools and the densities of the various types of schools and the financial support of city and rural schools. Title 1 funding was discussed and explained in reference to how schools received the funding with Dr. Roberts explaining specific guidelines for Title 1 criteria.
