Call to Order:

Introductions: Each member introduced themselves. Principal Purvis introduced himself and summarized his career.

Adoption of Today's Agenda: R. Brooks motioned that we keep the agenda without making changes, Mr. DiBernardo seconded the motion. Unanimously passed.

Approval of Previous Minutes: Minutes were approved with no corrections, motioned by A. Krecic and seconded by L. Muchnick. Unanimous approval.

Old Business: There was no unfinished business, therefore no Old Business to discuss

New Business:

A. 2021-2022 Budget was reviewed and discussed. A total of \$35,000 was approved for paying sitetech for 19 days of work during the summer, paying two assistant principals to work during the summer, to pay for employee to do IEP audits during the summer, to pay Frazer for scheduling during the summer, and for paying counselors to work on scheduling over the summer. Funds will come from ADS.

There was some discussion on where the money comes from and whether any of the money we have is "use it or lose it" money. It was explained that the ADS money does roll over. A question was asked by A Krecic if ADS money will be similar to previous years since COVID changed things. The answer was yes, it should remain similar.

Motion was made for approval by Mr. Hoffer and seconded by Mr. Brooks. Unanimously passed.

B. \$7,000 was requested for Bobcat Buddies program pairing up new to BHS teachers with teachers who have experience teaching at BHS. Money will be used to pay mentors. Question was asked by R. Ogando if this would be the first time SAC funded mentors. Answer was yes.

Motion to pass was made by Mr. Hoffer and seconded by Mr. Brooks. Unanimously passed. **C.** Fund request to purchase class sets of books by Ms. Goodnight was redirected. She will speak with Mr. Purvis and Mrs. Marrinoff about this.

Reports:

Principal:

Mr. Purvis updated us on prom, the mask policy, and graduation.

APC Report:

- Mrs. Chance
 - Student population is 2,307. Of those, 724 are Digital Academy and 1,583 are Brick and Mortar.
 - o Testing and registration are going on now.
 - Discussed Senior testing and undergraduate testing
 - DA Kids are allowed to come in to test after school or on weekends
 - There is a push to register specific students in advanced and AP classes

APSS Report:

- Mrs. Smith gave a COVID update.
 - o Drop in COVID numbers
 - 150 people took advantage of getting their shots at BHS.
 - o Only one out of the 10 students were not able to get a waiver.

APA Report:

- Mr. Jones talked about facilities
 - Gym resurfacing will happen soon
 - Cafeteria resurfacing will happen soon
 - New Pressure washer will be purchased soon.

Financial Report:

- K. Marinoff reports that
 - ADS funds are at \$152,701.64
 - Lottery funds are \$34,746.71 and it was noted that we have not received lottery funds in two years
 - School Recognition is \$70,406.02
 - Teachers Lead Funds are at \$0

Open Discussion – R. Goodnight talked about the services offered in the media center and made Media Center Faculty Guides available for the committee to look at.
