

Adult High School

Want to finish your graduation requirements and earn a high school diploma? You can through Alachua County Public Schools (ACPS) Adult High School.

Follow these steps:

1. Call (352) 955-7035 and ask to have your transcript reviewed.
2. If you need to take or re-take quite a few courses and also need state testing (FSA Reading, Algebra EOC, etc.), it may be better to prepare for the GED Exam. But if you only need a course or two its smarter to finish your standard high school diploma.
3. After reviewing your transcript our office will recommend which path to take. If it's high school diploma, call 955-7795 to make an appointment to register as an adult education high school student.
4. Registration must be done in person at the Adult High School office located at 3501 NE 12th Street. The cost is \$30 per semester.
5. The curriculum is online using Edgenuity. You will be given an orientation on how to login and access the courses you need. You may view instruction and take quizzes at home but chapter tests and exams must be proctored at the adult high school office.
6. Upon completion of all high school requirements (credits, GPA, EOC's, etc.) you will be issued an Alachua County Public Schools High School diploma.
