

## **ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF FRS STATUS AND ALTERNATIVE PLAN**

According to Florida Retirement System (FRS) rules, an employee filling a temporary position or employed as a substitute shall not be eligible for membership in the Florida Retirement System.
