# **UFLi**

- We start our mornings teaching UFLi. UFLi is a foundational reading skills program that focuses on decoding, encoding, and phonemic awareness.
- Not only does UFLi help students read it also aids in their fluency and spelling.
- Weekly practice skills are sent home by your homeroom teacher. More resources are available by clicking on the image.

### HOT AND COLD READS

At the start of each quarter, students are given an unseen passage to read within 1 minute. This is called a "cold" read. Words read incorrectly are deducted from the total number of words read to receive their wcpm (words correct per minute). Students then practice the passage for three weeks and are tested again at the end of this period. This is called the "hot" read. The purpose of the cold and hot read scores are to track a student's growth. This helps teachers understand who is still working on sounding out words and reading compared to who is reading fluently and working more on comprehending the passage. It is also a quiz grade in Skyward. Once a hot read has been assessed, students then begin a new cold read.





- Quizzes are given regularly as well as chapter tests.




# MATH AND ELA TEXTBOOK APPS

Math content can be found by clicking on the HMH Ed app that looks like this.






ELA textbook content is located using the Benchmark Universe app that looks like the following.




\* Go to the HMH ed app. Then click on the three lines in the top left corner of the page and then choose "Discover."


\* Next, click on the chapter your child is currently learning in school. Each chapter offers extra digital practice and parent support.






- Similar to iStation for reading, Waggle math is a digital platform students can use at home. They take an initial test to see what areas they need extra support in, and waggle then provides that extra support.
- > Students can first find the initial assessment under "assignments".





# BENCHMARK DASHBOARD






