

## ***Print Resources***

### **All citations:**

- \* Indent five spaces for every line after the first.
- \* If there is no author, start with the title.
- \* If bibliography is handwritten, underline the title instead of using italics.

### **Book with one author**

Last name, First name. *Title of Book*. City of Publication: Publisher, Copyright Date. Format of Publication.

### **Example:**

Caesar, Julius. *Ancient Rome*. Rome: Empire Books, 2009. Print.

### **Book with two or more authors**

Last name, First name, and First name Last name. *Title of Book*. City of Publication: Publisher, Copyright Date. Format of Publication.

- \* If a book has more than three authors you may use et al. Example: Tebow, Tim, et al.

### **Example:**

Tebow, Tim, and Urban Myer. *Life in the Swamp*. Gainesville: Gator Press, 2011. Print.

### **Book with an editor**

Last name, First name, ed. *Title of Book*. City of Publication: Publisher, Copyright Date. Format of Publication.

### **Example:**

Mouse, Mickey, ed. *Disney Theme Parks*. Orlando: Kingdom Publications, 1993. Print.

### **CultureGram**

"Name of Country." *Name of Publication*. City, State of Publication: Publisher, Date of Publication. Format of Publication.

### **Example:**

"Republic of China." *CultureGrams*. Orem, Utah: CultureGrams, 2006. Print.

### **Encyclopedias**

Author Last name, First name. "Title of Article." *Title of Encyclopedia*. Year. Format of Publication.

### **Example:**

Adams, Clark E. "Coyotes." *The World Book Encyclopedia*. 2011. Print.
