Funding Level and Description of Servi	ces		

Level 1 indicates that the student requires no services or assistance beyond those that are normally available to all students.

Level 2 indicates the student is receiving assistance on a periodic basis or receives minor supports, assistance, or services in one or more learning domains. For example, services at this level may include minimal accommodations to assist in accessing curriculum or learning environment, monthly services, and consultation.

Level 3 indicates the student is receiving accommodations to the learning environment that are more complex or is receiving services on a more frequent schedule in one or more learning domains. Level 3 services and supports may include accommodations, weekly services, collaboration, and assistance for some learning activities.

Level 4 indicates that the student is receiving specialized approaches, assistance, or equipment for the majority of learning experiences, or is receiving modifications to the learning environment in the learning domains of curriculum, behavior, independent functioning, health and communication. Services received on a daily basis are generally included at this level. For example, the student may require supervision during the majority of activities for physical safety or more frequent assistance with activities of daily living from a staff member.

Level 5 indicates that the student is receiving continuous and intense (one-on-one or very small group) assistance, multiple services, or substantial modifications for the majority of learning activities in multiple domains of curriculum, behavior, independent functioning, health, and communication. Services and supports at this level include continuous or constant intervention or assistance, intensive or individualized approaches and services for the majority of the day, and multiple services. For example, the student may receive a combination of health services, such as suctioning or the delivery of medications that necessitate continuous monitoring and assistance.
