CRA services related to the Half Cent Sales Tax Referendum:

Educational Facilities are governed by:

- State Statute
- State Requirements for Educational Facilities
- Florida Building Code

Educational Plant Survey

- Is a facilities planning document
- Required to add, remove and/or replace capacity
- Required to add, remove and/or replace square footage
- Required to remodel or renovate existing square footage

Capacity

- The number of students that may be housed in a facility at any given time based on a utilization percentage of the total number of existing satisfactory student stations
- Utilization percentage varies based on the type of school as specified in the State Requirements for Educational Facilities

Castaldi Analysis

- A cost analysis formula used to determine if it is more cost effective to replace a permanent building than to renovate or remodel the building
- Required for each permanent building the district wants to demolish
- Factors include age of the building, condition of the building, cost to rehabilitate the building and cost to construct a replacement building

Castaldi Analysis

- Holmes County Public Schools: Closed Bonifay Elementary & Bonifay Middle and transferred students to the new Bonifay K-8 School
- Hamilton County Public Schools: Closed 3 elementary schools (North Hamilton, Central Hamilton & South Hamilton) and transferred students to new Hamilton County Elementary (K-6)
