Welcome to Alachua County Schools. We look forward to working with you and your children. Below you will find information about enrolling your child in our schools.

To enroll your child in our schools for the first time, you will begin the process at the zoned school. You may go to your zoned school at any time during the school's regular hours. Schools are open during the summer, Mondays through Thursdays. If you do not know which school is the zoned school, the Zoning Office at the School Board of Alachua County can help you identify your child's school. Please contact the office at (352) 955-7700.

When enrolling your child at the school, you will need to provide the following paperwork:

- Two documents showing proof of residence such as a rental or lease agreement, electric bill, or property tax bill.
- Health records which include a physical and immunization record.
 Florida law requires certain immunizations for school entry depending
 on your child's age. The school nurse can help review your child's
 immunization record and transfer the information to the Florida form. If
 you do not have an immunization record, the school nurse can assist
 you.
- School records from your child's previous school or the name and address of your child's previous school.
- A document showing your child's name and age such as a birth certificate. If you do not have a copy of the birth certificate, the school can accept other documents such as an insurance policy or Baptismal certificate.

The ESOL Family Liaison Specialists can also provide language assistance to limited English proficient parents to help in identifying zoned schools and enrollment into the zoned school.
