



Let's beat Meningitis B together.

Get the facts:

Meningococcal disease is serious and can be fatal.

Approximately 40% of people with meningococcal disease will have serious complications such as brain damage or will not survive even with excellent medical care.

The best way to prevent all types of meningococcal disease is vaccination.

To be fully protected, two vaccines are needed – the new vaccine for Men B and one vaccine for types A, C, W, and Y.

You or your child may have received the meningitis vaccine that only covers type A,C,W, and Y.

Meningitis B is responsible for nearly half of the meningococcal infections in the U.S. Since the approval of a Meningitis B Vaccine in 2014, we can finally be best protected against meningococcal disease.
