### Family Assistance

Provide families with assistance in understanding academic standards, assessments, and how to monitor student progress.

Provide families with training and materials to help them support student academic achievement at home.

## Parent/Family Responsibilities

- Have daily to weekly communication with my child's teacher
- Check homework and graded work regularly via Skyward

- Support the school's discipline plan at home.
