GENERAL

- Santa Fe Dual Enrollment: The school counselors from Santa Fe Dual Enrollment will be visiting Buchholz on Monday, January 13th and Tuesday, January 14th during A and B lunch. Stop by their information table for additional information on Dual Enrollment.
- We are kicking off the new year with HPV, Meningitis and Hepatitis vaccines for 11th and 12th graders! - Forms were sent home Friday the 10th with all 11th and 12th grade students. The forms are due back to the school January 15th. The vaccine clinic will take place on Thursday, January 23rd at 8:00 AM in the auditorium. Two quick notes:
 - For seniors, colleges and universities require a student to have the meningitis vaccine (unless they have a religious waiver.)
 - The HPV vaccine can be very expensive and this is completely free to the students now. This vaccine protects against future cervical and testicular cancers.
- Anyone interested in being a member of the Student Council Class please stop by the front office to get an application. Applications are available from 1/13 to 1/30. Put completed applications in the basket in the front office. Final day for accepting application will be Friday, January 31st.
- Scholarship Opportunity - The Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority will award \$1,000 scholarships to deserving African-American high school seniors who demonstrate scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0 or higher) and who are active in volunteer community service.
