 - Submit a complete Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA), also known as the state application, no later than August 31, 2020, at https://www.FloridaStudentFinancialAidsg.org;
 - Complete the required coursework (by high school graduation 5/29/2020);
 - Achieve the required grade point average in the required coursework;
 - Complete the required number of service hours (by high school graduation 5/29/2020);
 - o Achieve the required college entrance exam score (no later than June 30, 2020).
