Reading at Home with a Beginning Reader

Before Reading

- Show the front of the book.
 - *Read the Title, talk about what the book may be about. (predicting)
 - *Identify the author, explain that is who wrote the book
 - *Identify the illustrator, explain that is who drew the pictures in the book.
- Show the back of the book.
- ♦ Show the spine of the book.
 - *show your child where their spine is.
- ♦ Take a picture walk.
 - *Name the items you see. You can place them into categories (like animals, plants, etc)
 - * Talk about the colors you see.

Make Reading Fun

- Use different voices for the characters.
- Read in a different spot, like: outside on a blanket, under the covers by flashlight, etc....
- Take turns reading each page, read the page together.
- ♦ Act out the story.
- Remember: it is okay to reread a story many times.

While Reading

- Talk about vocabulary, you think your child may not understand.
 - *use the pictures and the sentences around the word to explain what the word means.
- Talk about the actions in the story.
- Talk about the characters emotions and why they might feel that emotion.

After Reading

- Talk about the events in the story and the order they happened.
- Talk about the setting(s) in the story.
- Talk about what they liked and didn't like in the book and why. (or you can have them write or draw about it.)
