Free Covid-19 testing for students

Schools are now offering free Covid-19 testing for students who show significant symptoms of Covid-19 OR who have had significant contact with a person testing positive for Covid-19. This free testing provides results within approximately 24 hours.

This testing is <u>NOT</u> mandatory and <u>DOES</u>
require a parent consent form. The
school would never at any time test/swab
your child without your consent or
knowledge.

Just a reminder that at this time we must limit parent/guardian visits to our front office to essential purposes such as conferencing, student check out for appointments, clinic pick up, materials pick up, etcetera in order to limit the number of external visitors that enter the building during the school day.
