

Hello BHS Seniors!

Seniors will be able to paint their spot (**\$25 fee**) before school begins.

The schedule is as follows:

Pre-planning week, August 5 – August 9 during & after school hours.

First week of school, August 10 – August 13 after school hours

The school will NOT be providing any painting materials (paint, brushes, water buckets/water) or refreshments.

You are allowed to bring family members or friends to assist you in painting.

Although you can paint whatever you may like for your spot, **if it is deemed inappropriate, it will be painted over** by the school (no reference to alcohol, drugs, profanity, or sex).

All designs must be pre-approved.

Below are the size requirements for your design. Please **DO NOT** make it any larger than specified, your design must be a foot within the lines of the parking space and spot number. Please provide your own material as listed below.

Materials Checklist:

- Design of Length: 12 ft x Width: 6ft (bring measuring tape)
- Exterior latex house paint
- Paint Brushes/Rollers, Paint Trays
- Painter's Tape
- Sidewalk Chalk to sketch design
- Water buckets (WITH YOUR OWN WATER)
- Canopy for shade, sunscreen, sunglasses, etc. (optional, but recommended)
- Hand Sanitizer

Rules/Information

1. Please return this form completed in the boxes labeled "Painted Parking" in the office or in Mrs. Bower's room (4-066).
2. When your design is approved you will receive a text from Cabinet saying you are ready for Painting Day! If your design does not get approved you will receive a text saying you can submit another design. However, after the deadline, no submissions will be accepted, not even second time submissions. So, make sure your designs adhere to all rules!
3. Painting Day:
 Pre-planning week, August 4 – August 9 during & after school hours.
 First week of school, August 10 – August 13 after school hours
4. On painting day, when you show up, parking in the parking lot will not be allowed. Please park in the grass or at the church. Carpooling is encouraged as parking spaces may be limited!
5. When you arrive at the school, you must check-in at the parking lot entrance before you begin painting. Make sure you bring your own paint and your own brushed, WE WILL NOT PROVIDE SUPPLIES.
6. Before you begin painting, make sure you sweep your spot thoroughly, this will make painting much easier for you. Cabinet will have brooms you can borrow.
7. Your spots must be painted the same as your approved designs.
