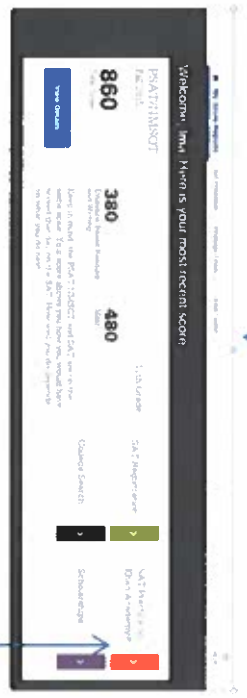
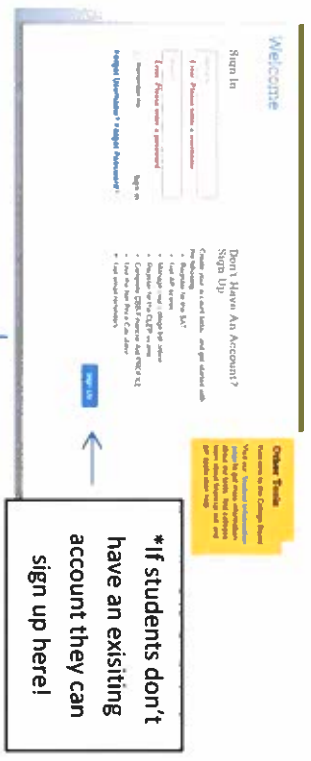

Steps to Linking with Official SAT Practice

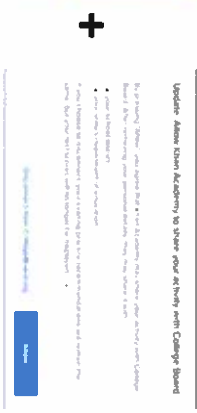
- 1: Visit (<https://www.khanacademy.org/sat>)

- 3: Students can sign in to Khan Academy using an existing account, Gmail (easiest), Facebook, or create a new account.
- 4: Once logged in, students will have two options to choose from:



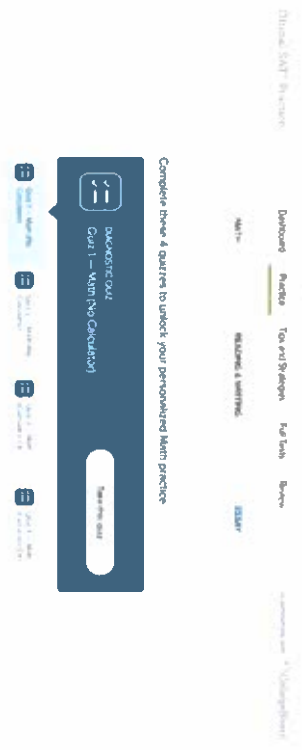

*Students will be prompted send their scores data

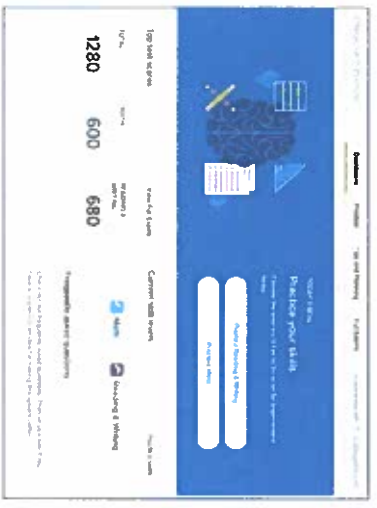

1. Signing up for a College Board account requires 2. Signing up for Khan Academy (Official SAT Practice: students to provide their given name, date of birth, home address, and an email address. (*If students already have an account, they will be prompted to connect to that account and if they create a duplicate account accidentally they can contact **(866) 433-7728**)
2. logging in using gmail, facebook, or students using another personal email. Using a personal email, will require the students being able to access that email to finalize setting up their account. Students will be prompted to create usernames and passwords during email signup.

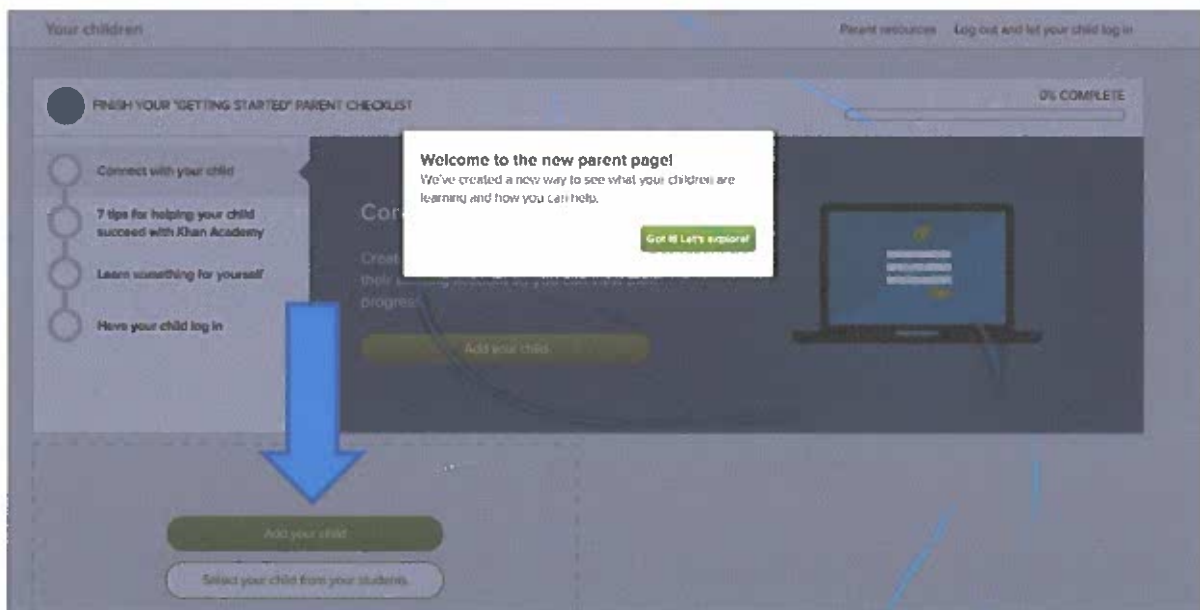
Creating Parent Accounts on Official SAT Practice

1. Parents may create an account at satpractice.org.
2. The parent will select the 'Parent' role when prompted.
3. Once the account is created, the parent will click on their username in the upper right hand corner and select 'Add Children'.



Personalized practice, anytime, anywhere—for FREE.

4. The parent will be prompted to visit the 'New Parent Page'. The parent may elect to follow the four steps of the 'Getting Started' Parent Checklist. If the parent elects not to do so at that time, the parent can begin with the 'Add your child' button.
5. The parent may select 'Add your child.'



6. It is not recommended that the parent create an account for their child. This is only applicable to children under the age of 13.
