REGISTRATION PROCESS

1. Review course offerings
2. Complete course request sheet (consult with teachers for recommendations)
3. Discuss with your parents
4. Turn in form to English teacher by:
Friday, February 28th
5. Counselors will meet with you for final review
-see schedule at end of presentation



REVIEW GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- English: 4 credits required
- Math: 4 credits required including Algebra 1 & Geometry
- Social Studies: 3 credits including World History, US History, Government, Economics
- Science: 3 credits required including Biology
- Art: 1 credit in art
- PE: 1 credit in physical education with the integration of health
- Electives: 8 electives
- Online: 1 online course
- Assessments: Must pass Algebra 1 EOC & Grade 10 FSA ELA
- GPA: 2.0 cumulative un-weighted



ONLINE COURSE

- One virtual course required to graduate
 - A “course” can be .5 credit or 1 credit- the requirement is met if you finish the entire “course”
 - Examples:
 - English is a full credit course. To meet the online requirement, you must take the full credit online
 - Personal Fitness is a .5 credit course. This course meets the online requirement even though it’s only .5 credit, because that is how long the course is



REQUIRED ELECTIVES

- 1 credit of art required to graduate- all art classes are noted with an "FA" on your registration sheets
- PE Requirement
 - Review options and courses on registration sheet
 - Choose your option and then choose courses if you need it
 - Sports Waivers** - DO NOT GIVE CREDIT! If you replace PE with a sports waiver you will need to pick up an extra elective somewhere else.



-ACADEMIC ELECTIVES-

- Colleges like to see challenging curriculum- do more than the minimum to stand out and to be prepared
 - *Psychology, AP Human Geography*
 - *World Languages* like French or Spanish
 - *Additional Math, Science, or Social Studies* courses (more than required)
- *2 Years of the Same World Language* is required for:
 - University Admissions
 - Bright Futures Scholarships
 - Scholar Diploma Designations (This is described more on our website)

- AP European History - Students will learn the history of Europe with major topics including: Exploration, Reformation, Napoleon, the Industrial Revolution and the World Wars
- TV Production 1 & 2-Students will produce a school news program, create videos in the field and become certified on Adobe Premiere Pro editing software.

- Jobs for Graduates- Juniors & Seniors, Talk to Mrs. Breman
- Food & Nutrition - Juniors & Seniors Only, Talk to Mrs. Ayers

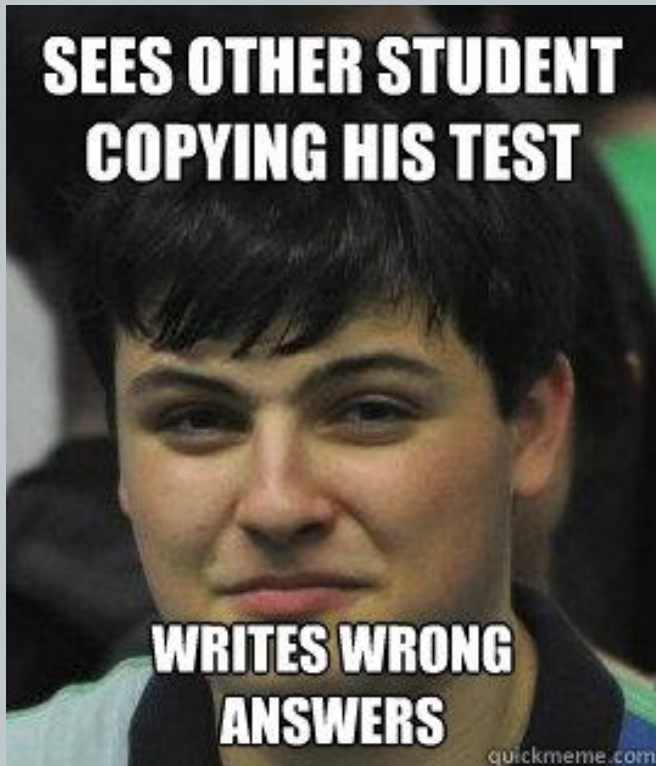

DUAL ENROLLMENT

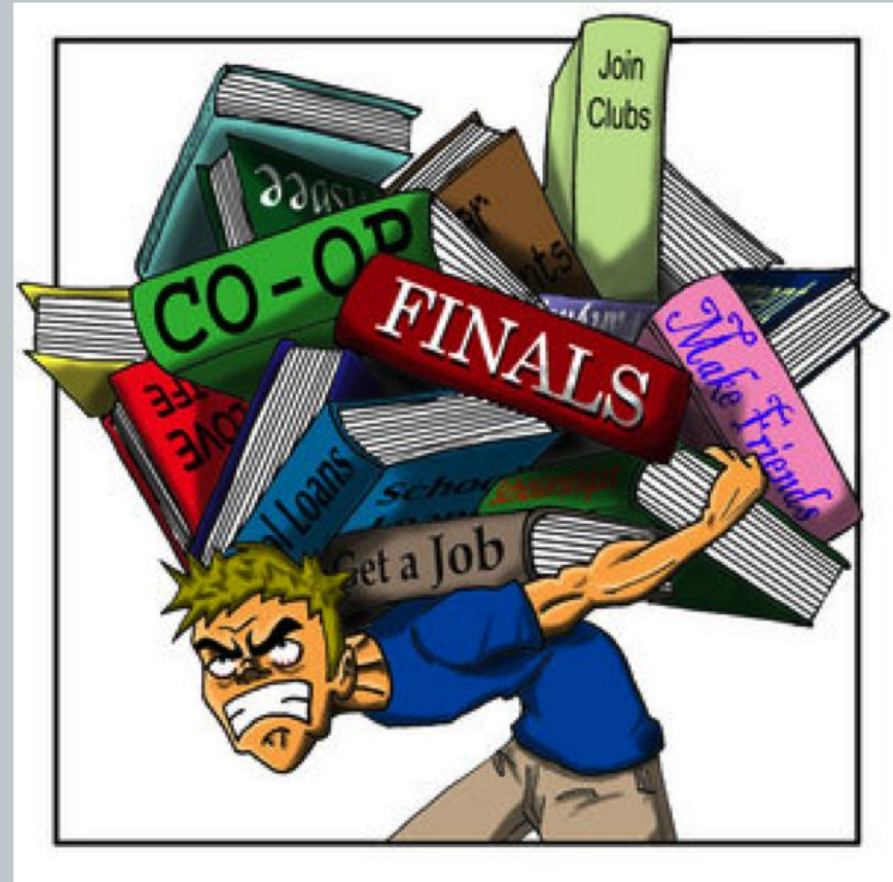
- Review school website for details

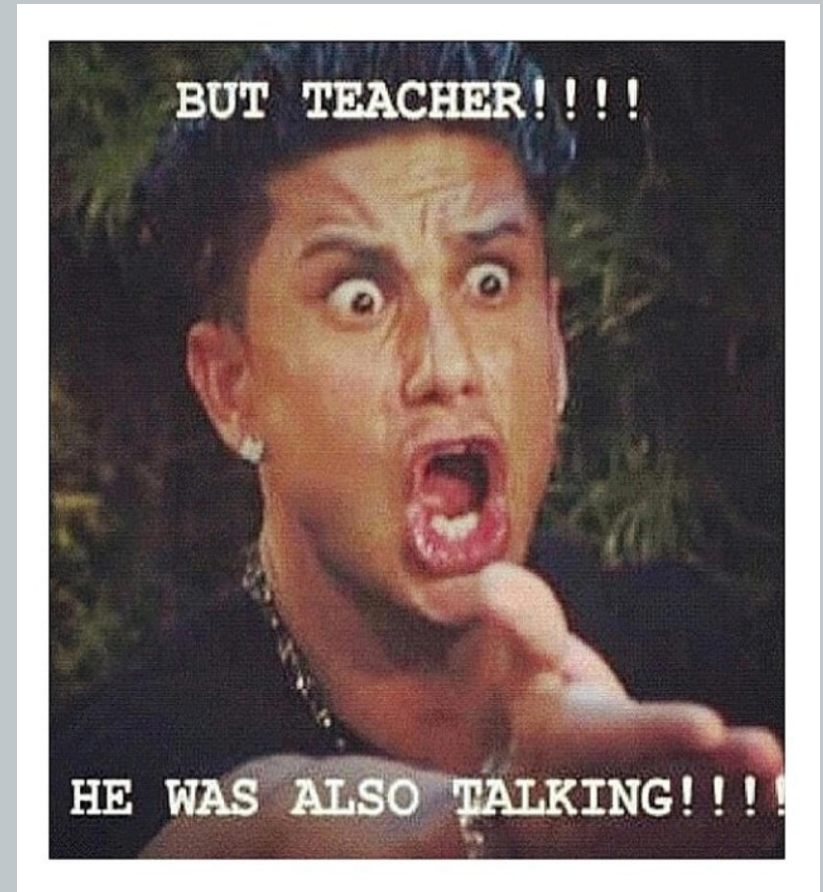
-KEEP IN MIND...
