SCHOOL ADVISORY COMMITTEE MINUTES
March 8, 2018

The meeting was called to Order: 6:00 pm by Chairperson John Bailey

Minutes: The review of the January 23, 2018 minutes will be held at the April 2018 meeting.

Financial Report: There was no financial report available at this meeting.

New Business:

SAC member Sam Cornell discussed school safety concerns as a result of a recent live shooter incident at a high school, which resulted in numerous deaths. Mr. Cornell presented a project that addresses a method to immediately respond to events that involves numerous traumas when First Responders are not yet on the scene or can't immediately access the scene.

He recommends that the campus have Emergency Trauma kits available at numerous key locations on campus. These kits would allow staff and faculty to administer emergency treatment in the minutes before First Responders can access the site and the injured.

These Trauma kits would include, but not limited to, tourniquets, pressure bandages, gauze, and gloves. The kits could be purchased ready made or materials could be gathered via donations and the kits developed. The cost for these kits could reach \$10,000 depending on how many kits the school needs and the method of purchase or donation/development.

Staff and faculty would be trained on how to use the medical supplies in these kits. There are resources available to assist with training and development of the kits via the Alachua County Sheriff Office.

All members present felt this was an excellent idea. Mr. Cornell, with assistance of some SAC members will investigate the options and costs and make a proposal for the April SAC meeting.

The topics of safety on campus and communication in emergency situations were discussed in general. Mr. TenBieg and Mr. Green shared some information about safety measures already in place as well as some the ACPS is working on.

Old Business:

Meeting was adjourned at 6:40 pm by Chairperson John Bailey.
