- Will childcare options be offered during the intersessions and Fridays off in July and August? EDEP is working to provide enriching activities and programs for students during these times.
- Why is this program offered only at Metcalfe and Rawlings Elementary Schools? These schools were intentionally chosen based on student data and approved to participate in the pilot program.
- Why was the year-round school pilot program created? Research has shown that year-round school programs improve attendance and academic performance.
