TEACHER SALARY INCREASE ALLOCATION

HB 641-TEACHER SALARY INCREASE ALLOCATION

HB 641 amends the FEFP and creates a new categorical as follows:

• Each school district and charter school shall use its share of the allocation to increase the minimum base salary for **full-time** classroom teachers as defined in s. 1012.01(2)(a) ...plus certified prekindergarten teachers funded in the FEFP, to at least \$47,500, or to the maximum amount achievable based on the allocation and as specified in the General Appropriations Act.

GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT – HOUSE BILL 500 I

- Proviso language stipulates that 80% of the total allocation is provided to increase the minimum base salary for **full-time** classroom teachers as defined in s. 1012.01(2)(a), F.S., plus certified prekindergarten teachers funded in the FEFP, but not including substitute teachers, to at least \$47,500, or to the maximum amount achievable based on the school district's allocation.
- 20% of the total allocation, plus any remaining funds from the district's share of the 80% allocation, shall be used by school districts as specified in s. 1011.62, F.S.

TEACHER SALARY INCREASE ALLOCATION – 80%

I. Each school district and charter school shall use its share of the allocation to increase the minimum base salary for **full-time** classroom teachers, as defined in Section 1012.01(2)(a), F.S., plus certified prekindergarten teachers funded in the FEFP, to at least \$47,500, **or to the maximum amount achievable** based on the allocation and as specified in the General Appropriations Act.

TEACHER SALARY INCREASE ALLOCATION – 20%

- 2. <u>In addition</u>, each district shall use the allocation to provide salary increase, <u>as funding</u> <u>permits</u>, for the following personnel:
 - a. **Full-time** classroom teachers, as defined in Section 1012.01(2)(a), F.S., plus certified pre-k teachers funded in the FEFP, who did not receive an increase **or** who received an increase of **less than two percent** under I or as specified in the General Appropriations Act. This does not apply to substitute teachers.
 - b. Other **full-time** instructional personnel as defined in Section 1012.01(2)(b)-(d), F.S.

- Each school district must submit the approved district salary distribution plan, along with the approved salary distribution plan for each charter school in the district, to the department by **October I, 2020**, of each fiscal year.
- By December 1, 2020, each school district must provide a preliminary report to DOE that includes a detailed summary explaining the school district's planned expenditure of the entire allocation received by the district.
