From the Principal:

Please ensure that your child arrives to school on time each day. The instructional day begins at 7:45 am, and campus is open each day beginning at 7:15 am. Chronic absence — missing 10 percent or more of school days due to absence for any reason—excused or unexcused absences—can translate into students having difficulty learning to read by the third-grade, achieving in middle school, and graduating from high school. Students can still fall behind if they miss just one or two days every few weeks.
