SCHOLARSHIPS

- The Southeastern States Pupil Transportation Conference (SESPTC) will grant a \$2,000 Buster Bynum Education Scholarship to one Florida student. Applicants must have a parent or guardian who is or has been an active employee in public school transportation during the past three years. This includes school bus drivers, aides, monitors, mechanics, parts clerks, foremen, managers, trainers, supervisors, directors and inspectors who work in public education. The student applicant must have at least a 3.0 (B) grade point average and is planning to attend a post-secondary educational institution starting in 2024. Applications are available on the Counselors Canvas Course or in the front office. The deadline is May 1, 2024.
- UF, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority: sponsoring the "By culture and By Merit" Scholarship to award high school seniors who attend Buchholz High School, Eastside High School, Santa Fe High School, Newberry High School, or Gainesville High School with a \$500 scholarship pending receipt of a completed application and required additional materials.
